 - d. A signed letter from your parent(s) explaining the need for financial assistance and notarized copies of their federal income tax Form 1040 (pages 1 & 2 only) filed last year as well as all current child support payment amounts whether court ordered or voluntary. (Please delete all social security numbers after notarization).
 - e. A list of other children in your family, their ages, and the schools which they attend.
 - f. A letter from your guidance counselor/director regarding your character, leadership ability and potential for success.
 - g. A letter containing the following information: Name and address of the higher education institution you plan to attend, number of years in your academic program, anticipated degree, and graduation date.
 - h. An essay describing what you see as your major challenges ahead and your future aspirations. This typed essay shall be a minimum of 300 words doubled spaced and no longer than two standard 8 ¹/₂" x 11" pages.
